LITTLE CAESAR PRESS was founded by Dennis Cooper in 1978, and in the ensuing years it has published twenty-four titles, including three books which are now out of print: Arthur Rimbaud's *Travels in Abyssinia and the Harar* (trans. by Scott Bell, 1979), Tim Dlugos' *Je Suis Ein Americano* (1979), and Dennis Cooper's *Tiger Beat* (1978), all illustrated at left and above.

Little Caesar's goal has been to concoct the most conducive packaging and develop the most thorough possible distribution for collections of today's brightest poetry and prose. Its original credo was "We like work that's on fire.
